## News Update.

### COVID-19:

As we remain in a National Lockdown, our main focus for February is to keep our communities safe and respond to COVID-19 breach reports. Keep yourself updated with the latest guidelines on the gov.uk website.

In January we received numerous reports of concerns for safety/breach of COVID-19 guidelines across the NL56 beat. These reports have been a variety of COVID-19 breaches including: different households mixing indoors/outdoors and businesses not adhering to guidelines. We have issued Fixed Penalty Notices and we have 'Engaged, Explained and Encouraged' where necessary. If you have a concern for a COVID-19 breach you can call 101 or report online via the Leicestershire Police website.

### Vehicle Crime:

We have had an increase in vehicle crime across the villages, these have been a mixture of catalytic converter thefts, theft from motor vehicles, and theft of number plates and theft of motor vehicles. Just a reminder to local residents to ensure your vehicle is locked even if you're leaving the vehicle for a short amount of time.

### Anti-Social Behaviour:

Currently most of our Anti-Social Behaviour reports do go hand-in-hand with our breaching of COVID-19 reports, where individuals are caught mixing households outside or travelling non-essentially, we have been taking appropriate action.



### Crime Update and Crime Prevention Advice.

As we have had an increase in vehicle crime, we are providing the following advice:

- Lock your vehicle. Even when filling up or parked on your drive, greatly reduces the possibilities of it being targeted by an opportunist thief.
- Keep the keys safe. Keep your keys out of view when at home and away from your front door.
- Park responsibly. Avoid parking in dark and secluded areas.
- Fit in good in-car security locks such as a steering wheel lock, gear lever or clutch pedal security device.
- Secure your number plates with tamper-resistant screws.
- Secure anything that's on the outside of your vehicle.
- Take it with you or hide it. Your mobile phone, coins for the car park, sunglasses, packs of medication or other items that can earn quick cash are irresistible to the opportunist thief.
- Vans are often targeted by thieves for the tools stored inside. If you have to leave tools in a van overnight, it's a good idea to mark them clearly with your name/company name and address using paint pens and seal with a clear lacquer spray.
