



NI56 Beat Update

Dear Residents,

I have returned from annual leave and I have reviewed the last 2 weeks of reported crime across the NL56 beat.

There has been a spate of various crimes in Quorn, there has been 2 reports of theft from motor vehicles and 2 reports of attempted burglaries, where suspects have been seen on CCTV trying to gain entry. These reports are currently under investigation.

In Rothley, we have had a spate of vehicle crime where 2 vans and 1 moped have been stolen. These reports are also currently under investigation.

A garden shed was broken into in Woodhouse Eaves and a bicycle was stolen. Unfortunately, we have no suspects for this report at this time.

There has been a spate of burglaries in Newtown Linford over the past month, these reports are being investigated and detectives at Loughborough Police Station are working hard to identify the suspects.

I understand that this hasn't been the most positive news, but we would like to thank residents for continued support and for supplying us with CCTV images which are assisting with our enquiries.

We are advising residents to report any suspicious behaviour to us via 101/report online on the Leicestershire Police website.

Just a reminder to residents:

- Remove any valuables inside your vehicles.
- Consider keeping your house/vehicle keys upstairs at night or kept in a secure place.
- Ensure your bicycles are kept secure using D-locks or bicycle anchors which can be placed in garages/sheds.
