



NI56 Beat Update

Dear Residents,

I have returned from rest days and I have reviewed the last 7 days of reported crime on the NL56 beat.

We have had 2 reports of criminal damage, one in Rothley and another in Quorn, no suspects have been identified at this time, but ongoing investigations are taking place. There was 1 reported theft in Cropston, items stolen from the front of a residential property and there was 1 reported vehicle crime in Quorn, theft of registration plates. Unfortunately, no suspects have identified for these at this time.

The beat team are continuing patrols as normal and we will be targeting 'hot spot' areas. We have been made aware of continuing graffiti within Quorn and surrounding villages, we are continuing to investigate this.

This is a good opportunity to meet your local policing team and to discuss your neighbourhood concerns.

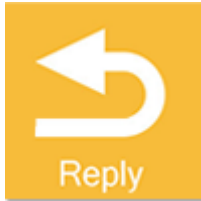
